

## iPad Use and Care Guidelines

Providing students with an individual iPad in a 1-to-1 environment provides an opportunity to enhance each student's overall learning experience. All iPads and apps installed on the iPads remain property of Jackson County Central School District and are subject to the same acceptable use guidelines as all other JCC provided electronic devices. JCC reserves the right to confiscate and search a student's iPad to ensure compliance with the Acceptable Use and Bullying Prohibition Policy. Students in violation of the Acceptable Use Policy or Bullying Prohibition policy may be subject to but not limited to; disciplinary action, repossession, or overnight confiscation of the iPad; the student will still be responsible for completing all school work assigned.

### iPad Care

- Keep food and liquid away from iPad.
- Keep the school provided case, or **acceptable** sturdier case, on the iPad at all times. If you would like to use a sturdier case, please see the technology department for a list of acceptable cases. Remember, the school issued case must be turned in at the end of the school year with the iPad and charger.
- Do not set anything heavy on the iPad.
- Clean with a soft, dry cloth.
- Defacing the iPad is prohibited (stickers, markers, etc.)
- Do not expose iPad to temperature extremes; don't leave it in a car.
- Use only your finger or an iPad designed stylus on the iPad.
- Treat your iPad with care at all times, do not throw or slide the iPad.
- If your iPad is lost, stolen, or damaged notify your teacher, principal, or technology department immediately.

### iPad Use

- The iPad should only be connected to the middle school syncing computer, do not connect your iPad to any other computer.
- Charging the iPad when the battery is below 25% will help extend the life of the battery, but make sure your battery has enough charge for a full school day.
- Adding and deleting of Apps is prohibited.
- While using the iPad, follow the school districts Bullying Prohibition Policy (514) and the Internet Acceptable Use and Safety Policy (524).
- Do not change any of the iPad configuration items, especially the iPad name, unless told to do so by your teacher. However you can change the wallpaper and background on your iPad.
- The whereabouts of the iPad should be known at all times. It is student's responsibility to keep their iPad safe and secure.
- The iPad camera and voice recorder should not be used in any manner that would violate the rights and privacy of other students or staff.
- iPads will not be taken into bathrooms or locker rooms.
- Please keep in mind the iPad is for the student's educational use, not for the use of the whole family.
